COMMANDER STONEY STOUTAMIRE, USN

CDR Stoney L. Stoutamire, a native of Hosford, Florida, entered the Navy as a Naval Aviation Cadet in 1965. Upon completion of flight training, he was commissioned and designated a Naval Aviator on 10 February 1967.

CDR Stoutamire's initial assignment was with Patrol Squadron SIXTEEN at NAS Jacksonville, Florida, flying the P-3A aircraft. He made deployments to Spain and Bermuda, with extended detachments to Argentina, Newfoundland and Iceland.

In June 1970, CDR Stoutamire reported to the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California. Here he completed the undergraduate program and was awarded a BA Degree in Government and International Relations in June 1972. Upon graduation, he reported to Naval Air Station Bermuda where he served as Communication Officer and as the Director of Special Services.

CDR Stoutamire was reassigned to the aircraft carrier USS Nimitz (CVN-68) in February 1977. He served as the ship's Communication Officer until 1979.

In August 1979, he reported to Patrol Squadron THIRTY for refresher training. Upon completion in December, he reported aboard Patrol Squadron SIXTEEN and assumed duties of the Assistant Maintenance Officer. He subsequently fleeted up to Maintenance Officer before reporting to the Office of the Joint Chiefs of Staff in April 1981. Here he served as the Executive Assistant to the Deputy Director of Tactical Command, Control and Communications, Joint Chiefs of Staff.

CDR Stoutamire reported to Patrol Squadron FORTY-FIVE in June 1983 and assumed the duties of Executive Officers on 8 July 1983.

CDR Stoutamire has been awarded the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Navy Achievement Medal with a Gold Star in lieu of a second award, Navy Expeditionary Medal, the Meritorious Unit Commendation Medal, the National Defense Medal, and the Sea Service Ribbon with three bronze stars.

CDR Stoutamire is married to the former Nancy Shepard of Gainesville, Florida. They reside in Orange Park with their two daughters Melissa and Kimberley.



COMMANDER THOMAS P. LAWLER

CDR Thomas P. Lawler is a native of Brooklyn, New York and a 1967 graduate of Saint John's University.

CDR Lawler's initial assignment was with Patrol Squadron SIXTEEN at NAS Jacksonville, Florida. Flying the P-3A, B, and C model aircraft, he participated in deployments to Bermuda and Sigonella, as well as UNITAS XIII.

In June 1973, CDR Lawler reported to the Naval Air Development Center in Warminster, Pennsylvania where he served first as the Legal Officer then as P-3C Update I & II Test and Evaluation Officer. Selected for the Personnel Exchange Program (PEP) with the United Kingdom, he served an overseas tour with the Royal Air Force at Kinloss, Scotland. He was subsequently assigned to the Naval War College in Newport, Rhode Island.

CDR Lawler returned to Patrol Aviation in December 1979 through assignment to Patrol Squadron THIRTY at NAS Jacksonville, Florida. During this tour with the Fleet Replacement Training Squadron (VP-30), CDR Lawler served as the Operations Officer.

Reporting aboard Patrol Squadron FIVE (VP-5), in May 1981, he served as the Operations Officer, while making a deployment to Sigonella. He returned to Patrol Squadron THIRTY (VP-30) in May 1983 as the Training Officer. CDR Lawler was selected for Patrol Aviation Command in October 1983.

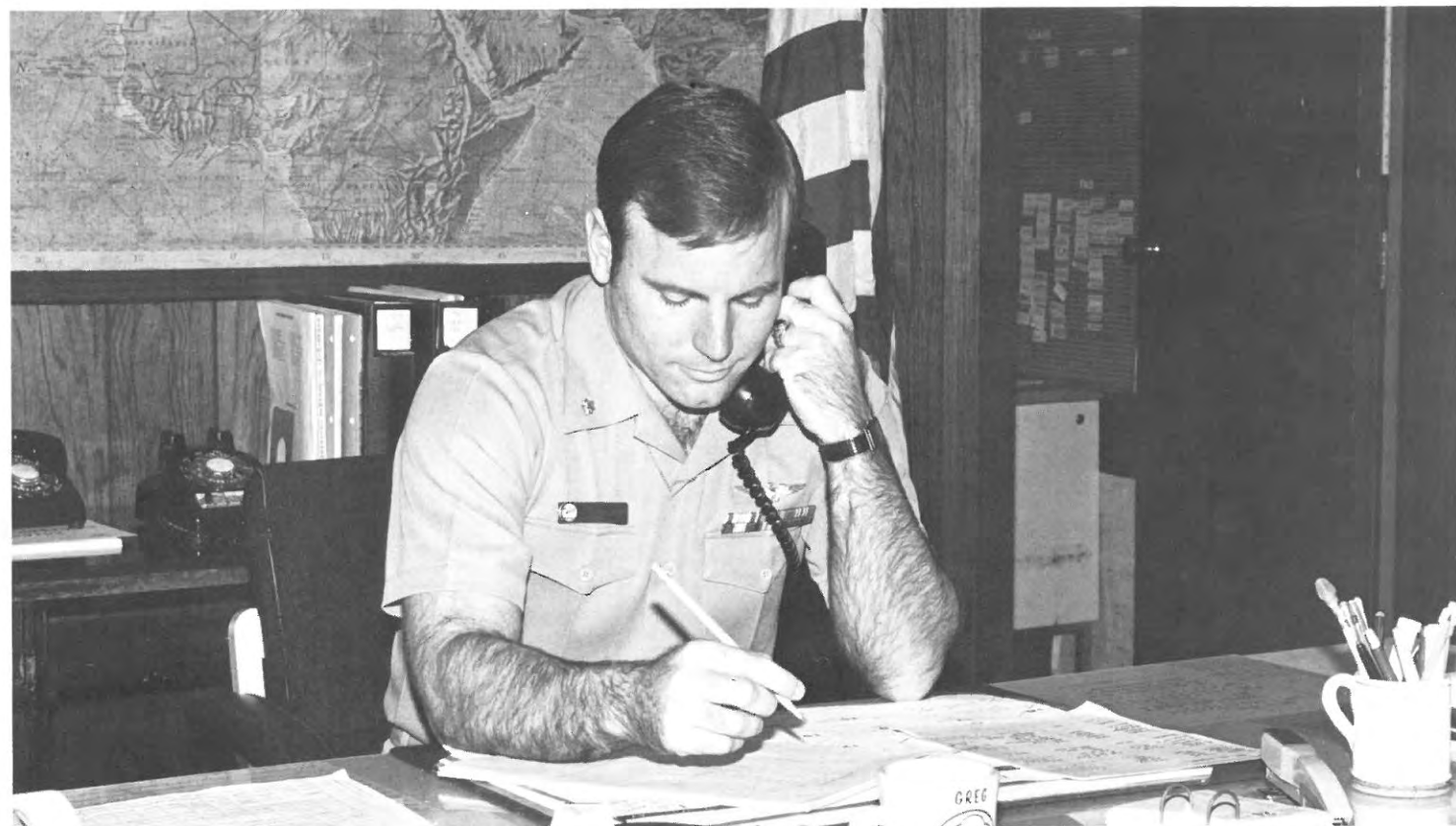
CDR Lawler reported to Patrol Squadron FORTY-FIVE in August 1984 and assumed the duties of Executive Officer on 31 August 1984.

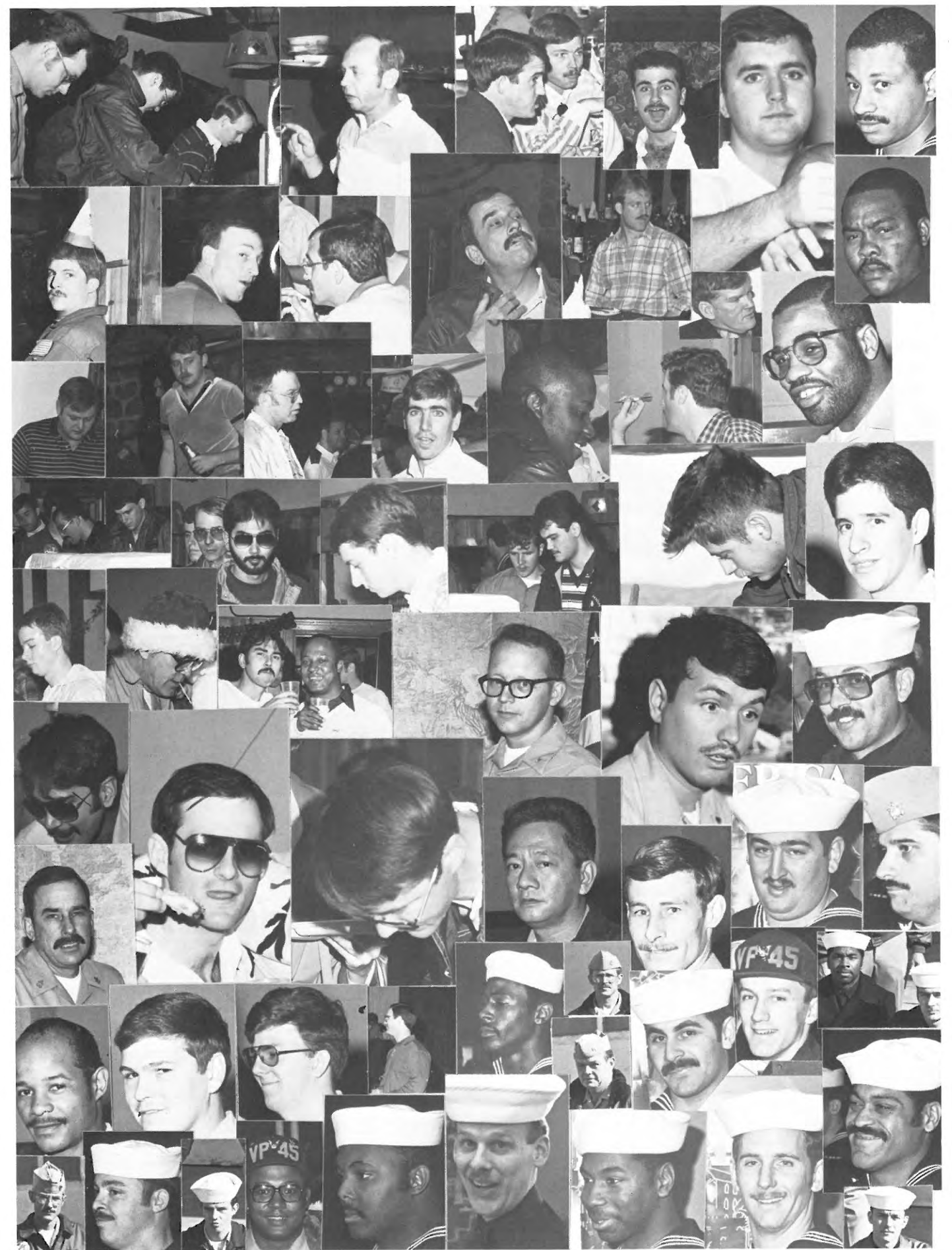
CDR Lawler is married to the former Margaret Burke of Brooklyn, New York and they reside in Jacksonville with their two daughters, Jeanne and Megan.

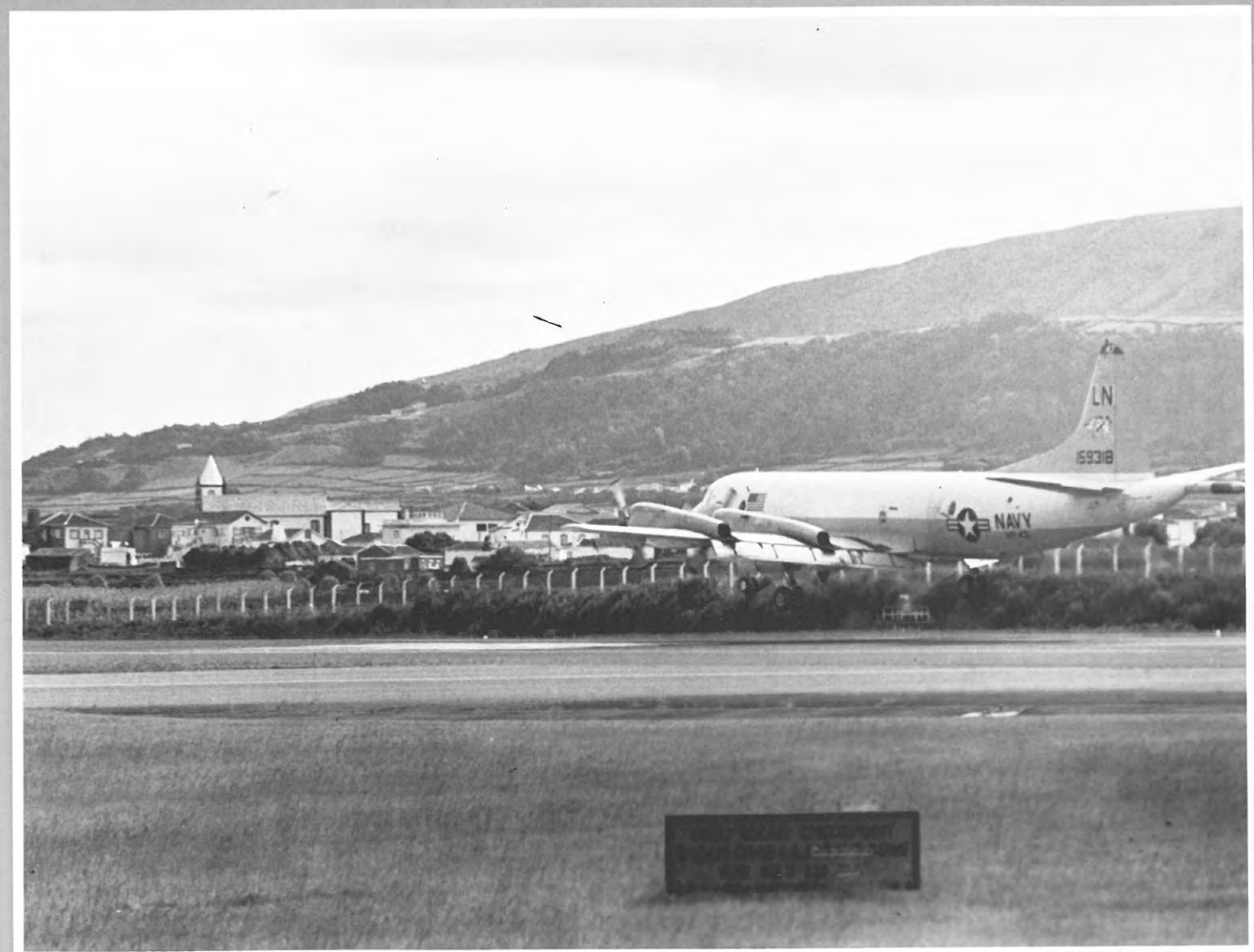




SOVIET COLLISION REPORTED

The collision, which left the merchant ship in distress and possibly sinking, was one of two or three unrelated incidents involving submarines around the world yesterday, they said.

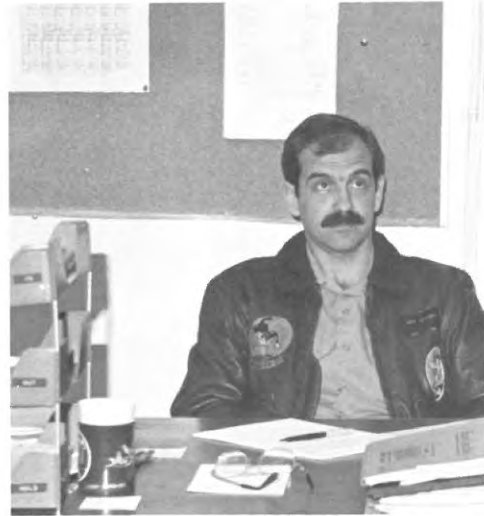
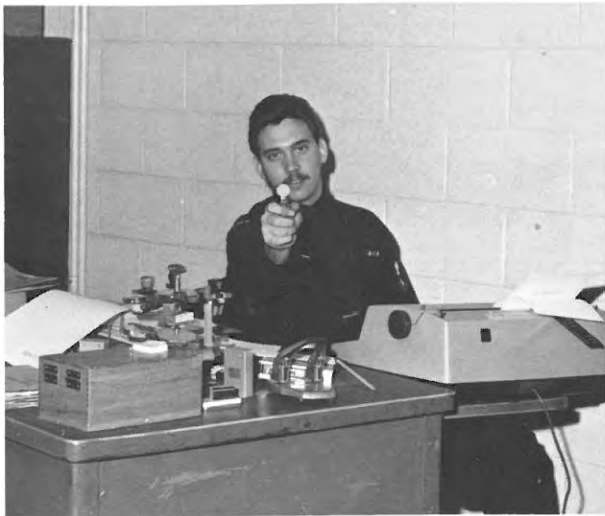
