COMMANDING OFFICER

CDR James R. Cannon

Commander Cannon was born in Leesburg, Florida, the son of Mr. and Mrs. T. S. Cannon. Following graduation from the University of Louisville he entered the Navy through the NROTC program. He received his commission in May 1974 and was designated a Naval Aviator in July 1975. After completing his initial training in the P-3C aircraft, Commander Cannon joined Patrol Squadron TWENTY-FOUR (VP-24) in Jacksonville in November 1975.

In December 1978, Commander Cannon reported for duty as a flight instructor in Patrol Squadron THIRTY (VP-30), the Fleet Replacement Squadron (FRS). He spent his first two years

with the "Pro's Nest" as Staff Training and Legal Officer, then served for fourteen months as Aircraft Division Officer.

Following enroute training, Commander Cannon reported aboard USS LEXINGTON (AVT 16) in March 1982. During training periods in the Atlantic Ocean and Gulf of Mexico he qualified as Officer of the Deck and Command Duty Officer (Underway). In this capacity he completed all requirements and was designated a Surface Warfare Officer.

Upon leaving USS LEXINGTON, Commander Cannon attended the University of North Florida as a student in the Advanced Education Program. He received his MBA with a Financial Management Subspeciality in August 1985.

Following enroute training, Commander Cannon joined Patrol Squadron FORTY-FOUR (VP-44) in Brunswick, Maine. While with the "Golden Pelicans" he served as Assistant Operations Officer and Aircraft Maintenance Officer.

Prior to reporting to Patrol Squadron FORTY-FIVE (VP-45), Commander Cannon served for thirteen months as the Logistics Officer on the staff of Commander Patrol Wing ELEVEN. In April of 1989, he reported aboard VP-45 as Executive Officer and assumed command of Patrol Squadron FORTY-FIVE on 27 April 1990.

EXECUTIVE OFFICER

CDR Robert B. Brannon

Commander Brannon is a native of Corsicana, Texas. He enlisted in the Navy at the age of 17, in 1968, and spent four years in Southern California as a plane captain and avionics technician on F-4s and A-4s, earning his Aircrew Wings as a SAR crewman in H-3s. Selected for the NESEP scholarship and commissioning program in 1972, he attended Purdue University, graduating in 1975 with honors in mathematics and Russian. He was commissioned an Ensign at Newport, Rhode Island in August 1975, commenced flight training, and was designated a Naval Flight Officer in February 1977.

After completion of Fleet Replacement Squadron VP-31, at Moffett Field, California in July 1977, Commander Brannon was assigned to Patrol Squadron ONE (VP-1) homeported at Barbers Point, Hawaii. In July 1980, Commander Brannon reported to the staff of the Commander in Chief, U.S. Pacific Fleet, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, as Flag Lieutenant.

In October 1982, after completion of required training in shiphandling and seamanship, Commander Brannon reported to USS MIDWAY (CV-41) homeported in Yokosuka, Japan, as Assistant Navigator. During his tour, Commander Brannon completed qualifications as Officer of the Deck (Underway), and Surface Warfare Officer.

In November 1984, he was reassigned to Patrol Squadron THIRTY (VP-30), where he served as Admin Officer and NFO Instructor. Commander Brannon reported to Patrol Squadron FIVE (VP-5), in February 1987, serving as Tactics Officer and Operations Officer. Since departing VP-5 in August 1988, Commander Brannon has completed assignments at the National Defense University (ICAF) in Washington, D.C. (during which time he participated in an exchange visit to the Soviet Union), and at Patrol Wing ELEVEN as the Assistant Operations Officer.

Commander Brannon reported aboard NAS Jacksonville, Florida in March, 1990 for duty as the Executive Officer of Patrol Squadron FORTY-FIVE.

R. August Hager

AVCM R. August Hager began his naval career in December 1966 through the delayed Entry Program. He reported to Boot Camp in San Diego, California in April 1967. After attending AT "A" school at NATTC Memphis, he served his first duty assignments with VA-174 at NAS Cecil Field as an Electronics Maintenance Technician on A-7 aircraft. He next joined VA-46 and made a Mediterranean cruise on board the **USS JOHN F.**

KENNEDY. It was during this cruise that he first re-enlisted in Valcha, Malta for orders to AVIC "B" school. After completing "B" school, he was accepted for duty involving flight and reported to in-flight training at VP-30, Patuxent River.

In August 1972, Master Chief Hager reported to VP-45 at NAS Jacksonville and completed the first P-3 "charlie" deployment to Sigonella in October 1973. Following deployment to Keflavik in 1974, he received orders to CTF-67 detachment Rota, Spain. In May 1978, he reported to VP-24 at NAS Jax where he remained on sea duty for seven and a half years making seven deployments to sites such as Keflavik, Rota-Lajes, Sigonella, and Bermuda. After an abbreviated tour of VP-30, he returned to the "Pelican's Nest" in April 1988 and assumed the duties of Command Master Chief.
